Dear Parents:

This School Year the Lucas Academic Boosters will be instituting a new program designed to give additional incentive to your student to achieve a higher academic level in core subject areas: Math, Science, Language Arts, Reading and Social Studies.

The program will be as follows:

Participants: 4th thru 7th Grade Students

Award: In the 4th Quarter of the 2009-2010 School Year all students who achieve the goals listed below will be awarded a Field Trip to the Cinemark Theatre in Ontario to watch a movie that will be approved by the school. The trip will include price of admission and a movie snack and will be funded by the Lucas Academic Boosters.

Program Goal: To give incentive to all Lucas Students, no matter their academic level, to raise their academic scores.

Your Student must meet the following requirements to receive the award:

- 1) During the current Quarter (2nd) students will need to raise their grade point average .5 above the level they achieved in the 1st Quarter.
- 2) In the 3rd Quarter students that raised their GPA .5 in the 2nd Quarter will need to maintain or raise their GPA in the 3rd Quarter in order to remain qualified.
- 3) All students with a 3.5 GPA or higher in the 2nd and 3rd Quarter will automatically qualify.

SECOND CHANCE!

4) If in fact a student did not meet Goal #1 in the 2nd Quarter they will have one more chance to qualify in the 3rd Quarter! However these students must raise their GPA a combined total of .6 in both 2nd & 3rd Quarters in order to qualify.

PLEASE NOTE: Mr. Barcroft will be sending home a flyer that will explain how to calculate grade point averages if you are unsure. This will enable you to help your child determine what grades they must achieve in order to qualify for the award. A students current GPA is stated on their grade card.
