

## Immunizations Required for Day Care, Head Start, Pre-School and School Attendance

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| <b>DTaP/DTP/DT<br/>/Td</b><br>Diphtheria,<br>Tetanus,<br>Pertussis | 4 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT or any combination.  | <b>Kindergarten</b> 5 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT, or any combination, if the fourth dose was administered prior to the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday<br><br><b>Grades 1-12 **</b><br>3-4 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT or Td or any combination.  |
| <b>POLIO</b>   | 3 doses of OPV or IPV or any combination of OPV or IPV.  | <b>Kindergarten</b> 4 doses if a combination of OPV or IPV was Administered. 4 doses of all OPV or all IPV is required if the third dose of either vaccine was administered prior to the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday<br><br><b>Grades 1-12</b><br>3 doses of OPV or IPV or any combination of OPV or IPV.   |
| <b>MMR</b><br><br>Measles,<br>Mumps,<br>Rubella                    | 1 dose of MMR administered on or after the first birthday  | <b>K-12</b> 2 doses of MMR. Dose 1 must be administered on or after the first birthday. The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after dose 1.  |
| <b>Hib</b><br><br>Haemophilus<br>Influenzae<br>Type b              | 3 or 4 doses depending on the vaccine type and the age when the child began the 1 <sup>st</sup> dose and the last dose is after 12 months<br><b>or</b><br>1 dose if given on or after 15 months of age | <b>None</b>  |
| <b>HEP B</b><br><br>Hepatitis B                                    | 3 doses of Hepatitis B   | <b>K-7</b> 3 doses of Hepatitis B. The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after the first. The third dose should be given at least 16 weeks after the first dose and at least 8 weeks after the second dose. The last dose in the series (third or fourth dose) should not be administered before age 24 weeks. ***<br><br><b>Grades 8-12</b><br>Hepatitis B not required |
| <b>Varicella<br/>(Chickenpox)</b>                                  | <b>None</b>  | <b>Kindergarten ONLY for 2006-07 (2007-08 will be K-1)</b><br>1 dose of varicella vaccine must be administered on or after the first birthday  |

\*The 5th dose of DTaP, DTP or DT, and 4th dose of Polio will not be required until Kindergarten. At Kindergarten, these doses will be required if the 4<sup>th</sup> DTaP and 3<sup>rd</sup> Polio were administered prior to the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday. The Hepatitis B and Varicella requirements will be progressive.

\*\*For students age 7 or older, if the third dose is Td a fourth dose is not required.

\*\*\*Previously, the third dose could not be given before the child was 6 months old. There has been a change, if the third dose is given at or after 24 weeks of age (as long as all the other spacing is correct), the dose counts and does not need to be repeated.

**NOTE:** The 4 day "grace" period applies to all age and interval minimums. If MMR and varicella have not been given on the same day they must be separated by 28 days with no grace period.

**Only full doses of vaccine using proper intervals shall be counted as valid doses.**
