ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION ITEMS

Mr. Herman updated the board:

- Covid-19 Update cases are declining. The week of February 14th had reported no new cases. The start of this week has yet to report any new cases.
- Boilers installation is happening.
- Reminder of the OSBA Central Region Spring Conference
- A 1963 Lucas Graduate, Professor Emeritus David Ervin, was inducted into The American Association for the Advancement of Science. This is an elite group of scientist, engineers and innovators recognized for their achievements and contributions to advancing human knowledge and understanding.
- 2022-2023 Lucas School Calendar:

Dane Farina spoke as to the importance of adding a few more 2 hour delays for Professional Development. PBIS, OIP, etc. are being implemented and the additional 2 hour delays would allow for more valuable training opportunities.

• Calamity Day Status:

Currently Elementary and High School are at 4 days and Middle School is 5 days.

Currently the school calendar is in excess of 100 hours.

If calamity days go beyond the 5 days, it is a recommendation to use remote learning on those days. Mr. Maglott was in agreement that remote days used in place of snow days would be better than adding days at the end of the school calendar. After discussion, it was determined that remote learning would be instituted in place of calamity days after the use of 5 calamity days. Due to excess hours in the calendar the Middle School will not begin remote learning until the 6th calamity day.

• Track Update-Garmann Miller:

Brian Wolf updated the Board mentioning that Vasco feels it is impossible to put in the 4 lane track without major changes. Vasco could put together a quote but it would be much higher than their original estimate. Garmann Miller is looking for an asphalt company to come in and do the ground work and base, and another vendor to complete the top coat.

Garmann Miller mentioned that there may be a need to remove the current base and put all new down. Brian Wolf mentioned that asphalt should run around 60-65K with extra for grind down.

Garmann Miller plans to bring any updates back to the Board.

Mrs. Arnold questioned the time line of the project. Per Brian it would be 30 days to complete prep work and asphalt. Then wait 30 days to spray the top coat and will need to wait a rest period of 30 days to complete all painting and other final touches.

• Football Field Update-Ryan Gregoire- Ag Design

Ryan updated the Board on Field Conditions.

New Track may require some repairs 5-6 feet in from edge on field.

Football field: the new sod is very tender in the beginning. 1st year went as planned.

2nd year Spring had the field bounce back and looked good, but the heat of summer left some bare spots Plan for this coming year is if bare spots are noticed will add Rye grass.

Football field is currently under a maintenance contract which allows for close monitoring of field conditions.

Graduation:

Students want to have it outside again. In the event of rain, it will be moved inside. Date of Graduation set for May 22, 2022.

Wayne Camp shared that he is for having it outside if that is what students want.
