



BARBARA MASTERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

At the conclusion of each school year, the President of the Athletic Booster Club will present a scholarship award in the amount of \$500 to one (1) deserving female and one (1) deserving male senior student who has been actively engaged in the athletic program at Lucas High School. This award is to be paid to the recipients upon submission of proof of successful completion of his/her first marking period in an institution of higher education. Recipient name(s) will be placed on a plaque on the Athletic Wall of Fame.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Applicant must have achieved a minimum 2.50 GPA at the conclusion of the 3rd grading period of the senior year.
2. Applicant must be accepted at an institution of higher learning.
3. Must have participated in sports for at least one (1) full season in high school.
4. Must compose and submit a handwritten essay.
5. Previous recipients may re-apply for this award, but will not be considered unless no current eligible senior has applied. To be eligible, previous recipients must have maintained a 2.0 GPA and still be enrolled at an institution of higher learning.

SELECTION PROCESS

1. Applicant must return all required and necessary information to the Guidance Office by the **1st Friday of April.**
2. The recipient(s) of this award will be selected by the scholarship committee, consisting of:
 - a. Two (2) officers of the Athletic Boosters (who are not parents of an applicant) as appointed by the President.
 - b. One (1) member of the Athletic Boosters or other qualified person (who is not a parent of an applicant) as appointed by the President.
 - c. The High School Guidance Counselor.
 - d. The High School Athletic Director.
3. The recipient(s) of this award will be selected based upon points earned in the following areas:
 - a. Athletics
 - i. Years of participation in athletics: five (5) points for each season of participation
 - ii. Varsity letters earned: two (2) points for each letter earned
 - b. Academics
 - i. Applicant may earn up to 20 points based upon the following scale:

4.00 = 20 pts.	3.91 - 3.99 = 18 pts.	3.81 - 3.90 = 16 pts.	3.61 - 3.80 = 14 pts.
3.48 - 3.60 = 12 pts.	3.36 - 3.45 = 10 pts.	3.26 - 3.35 = 8 pts.	3.16 - 3.25 = 6 pts.
2.96 - 3.15 = 4 pts.	2.81 - 2.95 = 3 pts.	2.66 - 2.80 = 2 pts.	2.50 - 2.65 = 1 pt.
 - c. Personal Characteristics
 - i. Character: applicant may earn up to fifteen (15) points in this category.
 - ii. Sportsmanship: applicant may earn up to fifteen (15) points in this category.
 - d. Quality of handwritten essay
 - i. Applicant may earn up to 50 points based upon the quality of his/her handwritten essay.
4. If, for any reason, the selected recipient(s) are unable to receive this award, the award will be presented to an alternate selection (name not to be identified unless original selection defaults).
