**Mr. Herman** updated the board:

- Track Update  
Rubber Down, still need lines painted, Garmann-Miller will be performing another walk through.  
Will be looking at fencing down the road.
- Elementary Roof  
The roof repairs at the Elementary have been completed.
- Football Field Vandalism  
At the present time it is in the hands of the Prosecutor's Office and Sherriff Department.  
Cost related to the vandalism: Ag Design – repair of field \$2100.00 now and then additional treatment services in Spring for an additional \$2100.00.  
Moving the game to Clear Fork at an estimated cost of \$2100.00.
- Alternative School Lunch Solution  
At the start of the current school year all lunch accounts were cleared due to donated funds.  
We above Me Alex Switzer Memorial has contacted the school about making a donation to cover students' lunches that would be in jeopardy of needing to take the alternative school lunch.  
Nancy the Food Service Director will create guidelines for use of the donated funds.
- Senior Citizens Breakfast  
The first Senior Citizens Breakfast for this year will be held October 18<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am in the Elementary and continue on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month that school is in session for the 2022-2023 school year.
- School Safety Grant  
The 2021 ARPA Ohio School Safety Grant has been received in the amount of \$149,100.67.  
These funds will be used on the infrastructure of the camera systems to improve coverage.  
Other upgrades under consideration include the door fobs and PA system.

Mr. Maglott has concerns about the 7<sup>th</sup> grades students demonstrating very poor behavior while a substitute was covering the classroom. Mr. Herman responded that he would be in contact with Mrs. Case.
